Dear Neighbor:

Atlanta Gas Light is proud to be part of the greater Atlanta community and provide natural gas service on behalf of certified marketers to the thousands of people who call it home. To ensure that those relying on natural gas have it when they need it most, we are upgrading and improving our system under the Georgia Strategic Infrastructure Development and Enhancement Program, or STRIDE, approved by the Georgia Public Service Commission (PSC) in October 2009.

In your area, we will soon begin preparations to construct a regulator station as part of our infrastructure improvements on the Johnson Header Pipeline which runs from west Fulton County to our liquefied natural gas facility in Cherokee County. The regulator station will be constructed on property owned by Atlanta Gas Light on Green Road near its intersection with Crabapple Road. Regulator stations allow Atlanta Gas Light to control gas flow in the distribution system as it moves into different sized pipes and ultimately to the homes and businesses we serve in your community.

Site preparation will begin in May. A section of the wooden fence that runs along our property line will be removed so that a construction fence can be erected around the work area. After this, the site will be cleared and graded in preparation for installation of the station. Once the construction area has been established, we will clean and test the pipeline in the area, and construct the regulator station. Work on the site is expected to be complete by the end of August.

Once construction is complete, the regulator station will be enclosed by soundproof fencing and the area around it will be attractively landscaped. Please see the enclosed rendering of what the final regulator station may look like. If it does not affect ongoing safe operations, we will also restore the wooden fence behind the neighborhood.

As with all of our construction projects, safety is our top priority. We will make every effort to minimize inconveniences to our neighbors on the job site. To ensure that the operations of the regulator station are not disruptive once it is in service, we are conducting pre- and post-construction noise surveys on the site.
